KEY ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITES

The caretaker shall be responsible but not limited to the following duties and responsibilities:

- Taking care of the cows/shed; this includes but not limited to milking, cutting feeds and repairs.
- Delivery of the milk to customers.
- Taking care of the rabbit facilities: This includes repairing the cages.
- Taking care of chicken hatches.
- Supporting in farm: this is preparation of farm for planting, actual planting, weeding, ensuring
 proper growth of crops by putting or spraying organic fertilizers and protective hormones to
 boost crops' growth, harvesting, decomposing manure for the farm and any other farm related
 activity that may arise.
- Spraying the cows, around the animal house and the compound.
- Ensuring safety and security of the above projects including assets and tools entrusted or that happen to be in his/her hands during the course of carrying out the duties.
- Mixing of biogas.
- Repairs and maintenance.
- Any other duty assigned by the management.

MINIMUM EDUCATION, KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

• Experience in animal care and renewable energy systems such as biogas and solar.
